Thank you for choosing Beautiful Soles! We are delighted to have the opportunity to teach your child(ren) dance. We do not take the opportunity lightly, but instead with utmost care, knowing the worth and heart of each student the Lord entrusts to us. This summary outlines basic program information and expectations for the 2017/2018 dance season.

Although we offer elements of a traditional dance program, you will find something different in our approach. We are a Christian dance ministry focused on honoring God and exalting His name. While teaching our students the art of dance they learn that dance requires both hard work and discipline; the same characteristics necessary for a strong Christian walk. A foundation of the Word of God, knowledge of the Lord, and personal relationship with Him are critical in understanding how to worship Him through dance. This does not mean that we ignore technical development, instead we strive for excellence in both. In fact, we have found that when a student approaches class with the correct attitude and willingness to work hard, he or she can learn very quickly and develop skill proficiently. It is our desire for each dancer to grow in the knowledge and love the Lord through participating in dance with us.

Inclement Weather Policy: If Mena Public Schools are closed due to inclement weather, classes will also be cancelled. If there is a tornado watch/warning during class time, all classes thereafter will be cancelled for the day. Please use discretion during severe weather conditions. If you have any questions/concerns about weather, feel free to text/call.

Dress Code: Modest attire is a necessity for all dancers. Leotards, skirts, and tights are recommended [but not required] for ages 3 - 4 years. T-shirts and stretchy athletic wear (capri-length leggings, one piece unitards, etc.) are permitted for 5 year olds and older. Clothes that are more fitted and comfortable are preferable for easier movement and help the teachers see placement of the students' bodies as well as instill the principle of discipline. Due to restriction of movement, jeans, jean shorts, or basketball shorts are not permitted. Crop tops (tops that show stomach) are not permitted for students to wear in class. When arms are raised, a dancer's stomach and bellybutton should not be exposed. Proper dance shoes must be worn to all classes. Shoes should never be worn outside. All hair is recommended to be secured back off the face (ponytail, bun or braid). Following all dress codes is important.
